

## Rustic Log Seating

**Material:** Timber from British grown trees, often cedar and sweet chestnut are used for durability

**Seat Height:** usually 500mm

**Finish:** Danish oil or untreated

**Installation:** Buried up to 600mm in the ground or special fixings

**Maintenance:** None, scrub with warm soapy water if required

**Notes:** A range of designs can be provided from simple log "perches" to carved trunk thrones and gossiping points.

**Cost:** From less than £100 for simple perches with the bark left on plus delivery, installation & VAT



A large chestnut or cedar trunk can also be cleaved into a circle of four seats to make a gossip point.

Rustic log seating can be simple chestnut logs buried in the ground with sanded tops or elaborate, carved thrones made from large diameter trunks.
